Students Code of Behaviour

This section must be read and signed by parent/guardian and participant

1. Each person treats everybody else with courtesy and respect.
2. Silence is kept during sleep hours so people are fresh and ready for the following days work.
3. People try to keep to the timetable to facilitate the achievement of the objectives of the week. Each person is expected to take full part in all exercises.
4. People do not enter the sleeping area during the day. At all times only females are allowed on the female corridor and only males are allowed on the male corridor.
5. No money or valuables are left in the sleeping areas but kept on your person or else handed up.
6. People join the groups they are assigned to; for wash- up, cleanup, sporting activities and in the sleeping areas.
7. Nobody leaves the premises/surrounding grounds without the permission of the Co-ordinator/Director.
8. Alcohol/Drugs are not permitted.
9. Mobile phones must be switched off during workshops.
10. All areas used are to be cleaned up at the end of the training.
11. Limerick Diocesan Pastoral Centre discourages smoking and smoking is prohibited inside the buildings.
12. Bullying will not be tolerated and the Pastoral Centre has a very strict anti-bullying policy. If you are being bullied or are aware of any bullying taking place you must inform the Co-ordinator or Director immediately.
