2. Last Supper Re-Enactment for Families:

Instructions:

Materials: Matzo (or crackers), red grape juice, 2 candles, glasses for juice, white paper table cloth (if possible), basin and jug, towel, crucifix

Introduction: We remember this very holy night just before Jesus died on the cross, when he gathered with the apostles, his greatest friends, to celebrate the Passover. What was this celebration like? Like a party, they all sat around the table and ate and drank wine. What did he say that was completely new? This is my body which will be given up for you. What does it mean for us? We can receive Jesus at Mass and we can be with God forever in Heaven at the end of our lives. Our celebration won't be the same as the Passover or the Mass- our bread and wine don't become Jesus.
