## FOR YOUR SAFETY AND ENJOYMENT

- Youth 2000 retreats are provided for those between the ages of 16–35 years. Anyone outside of this age bracket may attend by day only but cannot stay on site at night.
- The consumption of alcohol & recreational drugs is strictly forbidden. Those who have consumed any such substances will not be allowed to stay on site and will be asked to leave.
- Participants are asked to maintain acceptable standards of behaviour and act in a law-abiding, mature and honest manner. Failure to do so may result in a participant being asked to leave.
- All participants must register and should advise staff when leaving the event.
- ID is required by all those attending our events. Those who are under 18 must provide a signed parental consent form. All information provided to Youth 2000 must be accurate. A participant may be asked to leave if he/she willingly discloses false information.
- Separate accommodation is provided for males and females. Please do not enter areas that are not allocated for you.
- Access to the outer extends of the grounds is strictly forbidden.
- Each person is responsible for their personal items. Youth 2000 Ireland will not be held responsible /liable for any property lost, damaged or stolen.

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Participants are obliged to partake in the full programme throughout the duration of the event.
- Under 18s are not permitted to leave the retreat area under any circumstances without the Safeguarding Officer receiving permission from their parent or legal guardian.
- Under 18s must check-in with their assigned guardians at all designated times and follow all instructions given by the Safeguarding Officer.
- Name badges and wristbands must be worn at all times for the duration of the event.
- Please observe silence around the Main Hall and Blessed Sacrament Chapel.
- Smoking is not permitted inside any buildings or facilities. Please dispose of all cigarettes safely in the designated areas.
- Failure to respect others, the premises or any property or equipment will result in the participant in question being asked to leave.
- Please make every effort to keep each area that you use clean and tidy.
